

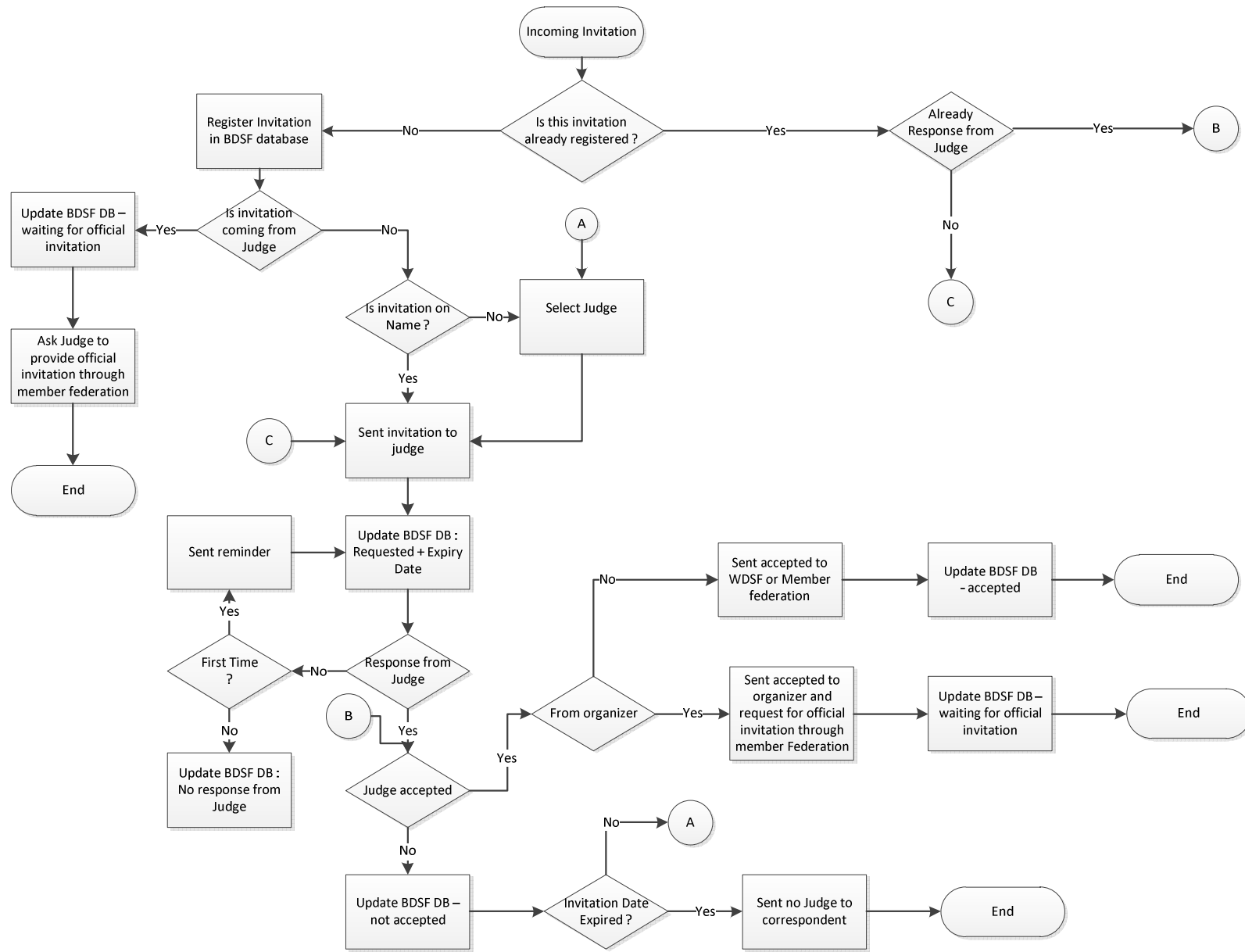
Procedure for incoming judges invitations

Incoming international invitations for judges can at BDSF come in through different channels :

- From WDSF
- From another WDSF member federation
- From an organizer of a competition
- From the judges himself contacted directly by the organizer

This document is describing the procedure to follow in the different cases and the actions to be taken by the different involved parties.

The general principle is that every invitation must be registered at BDSF and confirmed by the WDSF member federation or WDSF (for championships and cups). The adjudicator has always to notify BDSF when accepting the invitation independent of the channel its coming in.



The following measures will be taken, when procedure is not followed by the adjudicator:

- First infraction : official warning
- Second infraction : suspension of adjudicators license (national and international) for 1 month
- Third infraction : suspension of adjudicators license (national and international) for 6 month
- 4th infraction : suspension of adjudicators license (national and international) for 2 years
- 5th infraction : final suspension of adjudicators license

A warning and infractions will be barred when there is no infraction during five years.
